Re: Application of the Waverly Sanitary District, Calumet County, Wisconsin, as a Water Public Utility, for Utility Name Change and Tariff Revisions 6335-TW-100

Dear Mr. Parish:

This letter is in response to your request dated September 6, 2017, to change the name of your utility. ([PSC REF#: 332640](#).) Your application states that on July 25, 2017, the Village of Harrison annexed territory in the Town of Harrison which included the entire Waverly Sanitary District. Your application also states that the Village-owned water utility, hereby known as Harrison Utilities, will continue to serve the entire area formerly served by the Waverly Sanitary District.

Commission staff reviewed your request and has revised all rate schedules and tariff sheets to allow for the utility name change. Copies of the new schedules are attached for your reference. The new tariff sheets have been filed at the Commission under Amendment 15 with an effective date of November 30, 2017. Please note, Commission staff has updated your prior tariff sheets' language with standard language to be consistent with other utilities going through rate cases and tariff revisions. For example, Commission staff is replacing Schedule Mgt-1, Seasonal, Emergency, or Temporary Service, with a new Schedule Sg-1, Seasonal Service and is also eliminating Schedule Mz-1, Building and Construction Water Service, because the revised Schedule Ug-1 now applies to these customers.

While your water utility name has been changed in our files to Harrison Utilities, your identification number, 6335, will remain the same. Please note that your utility operations and service obligations also remain unchanged.

Please note that the Village of Harrison shall make these tariff changes available to the public at locations where customer payments are accepted, on the utility's Internet site, or in a form and place that is otherwise readily accessible to the public, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 196.19. If a copy of the new tariffs are not made available to the public by one day before the effective date, the new tariff provisions shall take effect one day after the date they are made available to the public.


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Please update your current tariff by inserting printed copies of the new tariff sheets into the current tariff books. Mark any old rates as "Superseded" and keep them permanently in a separate file pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § 185.19. The utility's current rates and rules must be available for public inspection and review at all of the utility's bill payment stations and at area libraries, pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § 185.22.

This filing is made with the understanding that it does not result in an unauthorized rate increase or service restriction. Additionally, as required by Wis. Stat. § 196.60, the provisions of the filing shall be applied in a non-discriminatory manner.
