**Re: 2016 Town of Harrison Paver Patching / Black Slag Chip Seal Program contracted with Scott Construction Inc.**

This summer we will be applying a Black Slag Chip Seal to your roadway. This very economical surface treatment prolongs the life of the asphalt. Timely preventative maintenance like this helps avoid extremely costly street rebuilding projects that could substantially increase your taxes.

First, the road will be swept clean (*some streets have already received cold mix paver patching/ wedging prior*) and oil (asphalt) will be placed down. Once the oil is down, the black slag chips are then applied to the roadway which is set in place by a roller prior to the oil hardening. After the streets have been sealed, the streets need to cure for up to 7 to 14 days, after which the streets will be vacuum swept for excess black slag chips. If any of the chip material ends up on your property, you may wish to sweep the chips to the edge of the road for removal before the sweeping operation.


Since the oil that is applied to hold the black slag chip will continue to harden for the next 7-14 days, it may be susceptible to damage and tracking onto adjacent pavements and driveways if you drive on it. Therefore, if you need to drive on your street during or just after the chip sealing operation, please use caution and extra care to avoid dislodging the chips and tracking the oil. Things to watch out for to help stop any damage or tracking will be things like: when backing into or out of your driveway take caution not to turn the wheels on your vehicle while stopped or abrupt acceleration or deceleration.

When Scott Construction Inc. begins the black slag chip seal process, there will be times of inconvenience caused by limiting access to your street and driveways. These times however are very short. The black slag chip seal on each street should be completed within one working day. You are able to drive on the chips once they are placed on the road.
