**WARDS 3, 4, 11, 12, 13, 17, 18      WAVERLY BEACH BAR AND GRILLE, N8770 FIRELANE 1 (BALLROOM)**

**WARDS 5, 6, 10      HARRISON MUNICIPAL BUILDING, W5298 HWY 114 (COMMUNITY ROOM)**

**WARDS 7, 8, 9, 14, 15, 16      HARRISON MUNICIPAL BUILDING, W5298 HWY 114 (PUBLIC WORKS SHOP)**

*If you have previously voted at Christ the Rock, you have been moved to Waverly Beach Bar and Grille in the Ballroom. Christ the Rock is closed for the Presidential Election, but may reopen in 2021.*

*Voters reporting to the Community Room at the Municipal Building should enter at the main entrance (west door facing State Park Road)*

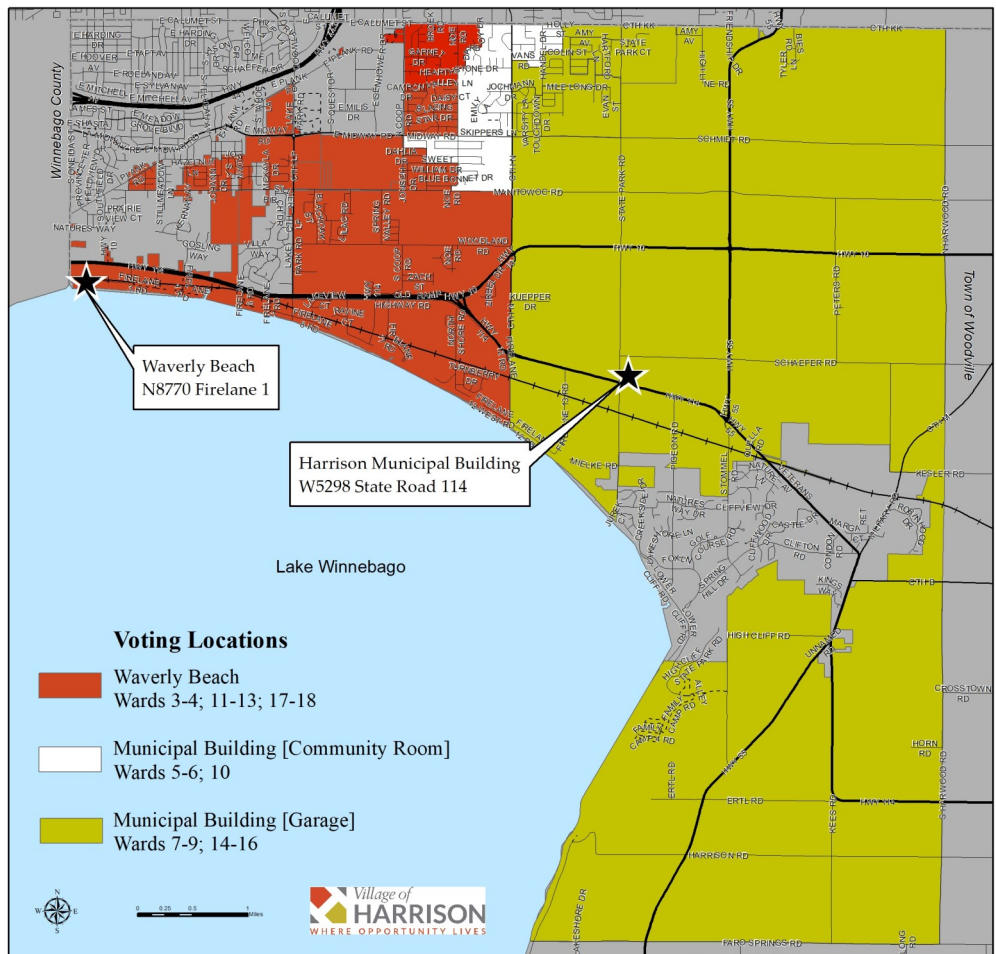
*Voters reporting to the Public Works Shop at the Municipal Building should enter through the service door (south door facing Hwy 114)*



If you have moved since you last voted, you must register under the new address.

If you have changed your name since you last voted, you must register under the new name.

The State of Wisconsin marks voters inactive if 4 years have passed since you last voted. If you are marked inactive, you will need to register again.



## You have 3 ways to vote this November!

### Voting at the Polls

You can cast your ballot at your polling place on Election Day from 7:00am to 8:00pm. To find your polling place, visit [myvote.wi.gov](http://myvote.wi.gov) or call us at 989-1062

### In-Person Voting by Absentee Ballot

You can cast an absentee ballot in the office beginning Tuesday, October 20, 2020 at 8:00am. Due to Covid-19, we will be taking two voters at a time. Check our website at [www.harrison-wi.org](http://www.harrison-wi.org) for up-to-date info.

### Voting Absentee Ballot by Mail

You can request a ballot at [myvote.wi.gov](http://myvote.wi.gov). You can also make a written request, along with photo ID, to:

Requests must be received by 5:00pm on October 29, 2020

Once you receive your absentee ballot by mail, you'll receive specific instructions about how to fill it out and securely send it back to the clerk in time for Election Day. Be sure to follow the instructions carefully because inaccurate or incomplete information could prevent your vote from being counted. One thing to keep in mind is that you'll need to have a witness observe your vote and then sign your certificate envelope. The witness must also provide his/her address. It can be any adult U.S. citizen who isn't an election candidate. Once your ballot is complete, simply mail it back in the postage-paid envelope. If you prefer, you can drop it off at the Harrison Municipal Building. There is a drop box located near the main entrance.

**\*NEW\* You can now track the delivery and receipt of your absentee ballot under the My Voter Info tab on My Vote!**

No matter how you cast your ballot, most voters will need to show acceptable photo ID. Visit [bringit.wi.gov](http://bringit.wi.gov) to see a complete list of acceptable photo IDs and learn how to get a photo ID for free, if you don't have one.
