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**Title:**

Old Business- Clarification on Phone Stipend

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**Issue:**

Village Clerk is requesting clarification on the motion approved at the 04/24/18 meeting.

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**Background and Additional Information:**

The motion approved at the April 24<sup>th</sup> meeting was, “Village employees that need to be reached 24 hours a day and wish to use their personal devices have the option of a \$40 monthly stipend. The Public Works Director and Operations Manager will be provided a phone. The paging system needs to be added to all phones.”

First, there is currently no policy or document in place that defines which employees “need to be reached 24 hours a day.” Second, all Harrison Fire Rescue members receive W-2s and are considered village employees. Therefore, they would fall under the approved motion but I do not believe that was probably the intent at the time of the discussion. Third, does the motion cover Harrison Utilities employees?

Furthermore, the board approved a monthly stipend of \$30 for the 3 Deputy Chiefs at the January 30<sup>th</sup> meeting. Under this recent motion, I believe they could argue that their monthly stipend should be increased from \$30 to \$40.

I ask that there be supporting documents on file to accompany the payment of these stipends.

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**Recommended Action:**

Authorize staff to either update job descriptions, the employee handbook, or create a cell phone policy.

expectation of privacy in regard to electronic communications, computers, internet use or data.

No computer hardware, software, peripheral equipment, documentation or data shall be removed from Village premises without express permission from the Administrator. All communications and information transmitted by, received from, or stored in the Village's system are Village records and the property of the Village.

The Internet and Email systems shall only be used by Village employees in the performance of their jobs. The limited use of the Internet and Email for personal purposes is permitted to the extent that such use does not compromise employee productivity or interfere with the conduct of Village business. Employees may not use Village equipment or systems for self-employment, employment with another employer or for activities resulting in profit to the employee.

Employees may not use the Village's resources to pay additional access or subscription fees without the authorization of the Village Manager. Employees should expect no privacy with respect to use of computers, this lack of privacy also extends to any purely personal use employees may make of village systems.

The following are prohibited activities:

- a) Jeopardizing the security of the Village's systems.
- b) Gaining unauthorized access to Village systems or records, remote computers or other systems.
- c) Using someone else's code or password without authorization.
- d) Enabling unauthorized third parties to have access or to use the Village's systems.
- e) Opening misaddressed E-mail.
- f) Illegal activities.
- g) Conducting non-work related private business.
- h) Participating in any gambling activities.
- i) Visiting pornographic sites.
- j) Engaging in political activities.
- k) Transmitting or creating comments/images that would offend on the basis of race, gender, national origin, sexual orientation, religion, political beliefs or disability, or that would otherwise violate the Village's harassment policy.

#### **4. Use of Cell Phones**

It is the purpose of this policy to provide employees guidelines regarding the personal use of Village cell phones. It is the policy of the Village that all cell phones are for the express purpose of conducting Village business. The Village recognizes that on occasion, situations may arise necessitating the personal use of Village cell phones by employees. Such use is to be kept to a minimum and any excess charges will be paid by the employee. Use of any cell phone for personal use shall be kept to a minimum.

- a) Supervisory personnel have no limit on personal calls if they are expected to answer work calls 24 hours a day.

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**Title:**

Agreement to Place Shed in Drainage Easement – N9641 Darboy Drive

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**Issue:**

Should the Village Board approve the placement of a shed in a drainage easement?

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**Background and Additional Information:**

The property owner at N9641 Darboy Drive is requesting permission to place a 8'x10' shed within a drainage easement along the rear (west side) of the property. The property is Lot 35 of the Darbroek Acres subdivision. There is a 40-foot drainage easement along the west side of the property for an intermediate stream.

There are existing plantings/trees and a retaining wall within the easement area. The property owner has stated that the retaining wall and plantings were granted approval from Garner's Creek Storm Water Utility 8-10 years ago. The property owner wishes to construct the shed on top of the retaining wall, approximately 30' from the property line.

The zoning ordinance requires approval from the easement holder prior to issuance of a zoning permit for the shed. In this case, the Village Board must decide if a fence is allowed in the easement as it is a drainage easement.

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**Budget Impacts:**

None

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**Recommended Action:**

Staff does not find any concerns with the placement of the shed on top of the retaining wall area since there will be no additional impacts to the drainage easement. If the shed is approved within the easement, staff recommends that the standard Permission to Occupy Drainage Easement Agreement be signed and recorded with the Calumet County Register of Deeds prior to the shed permit being issued.

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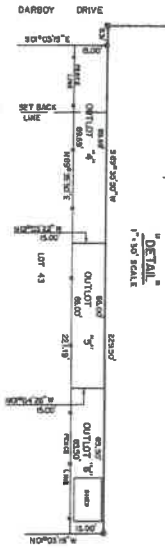
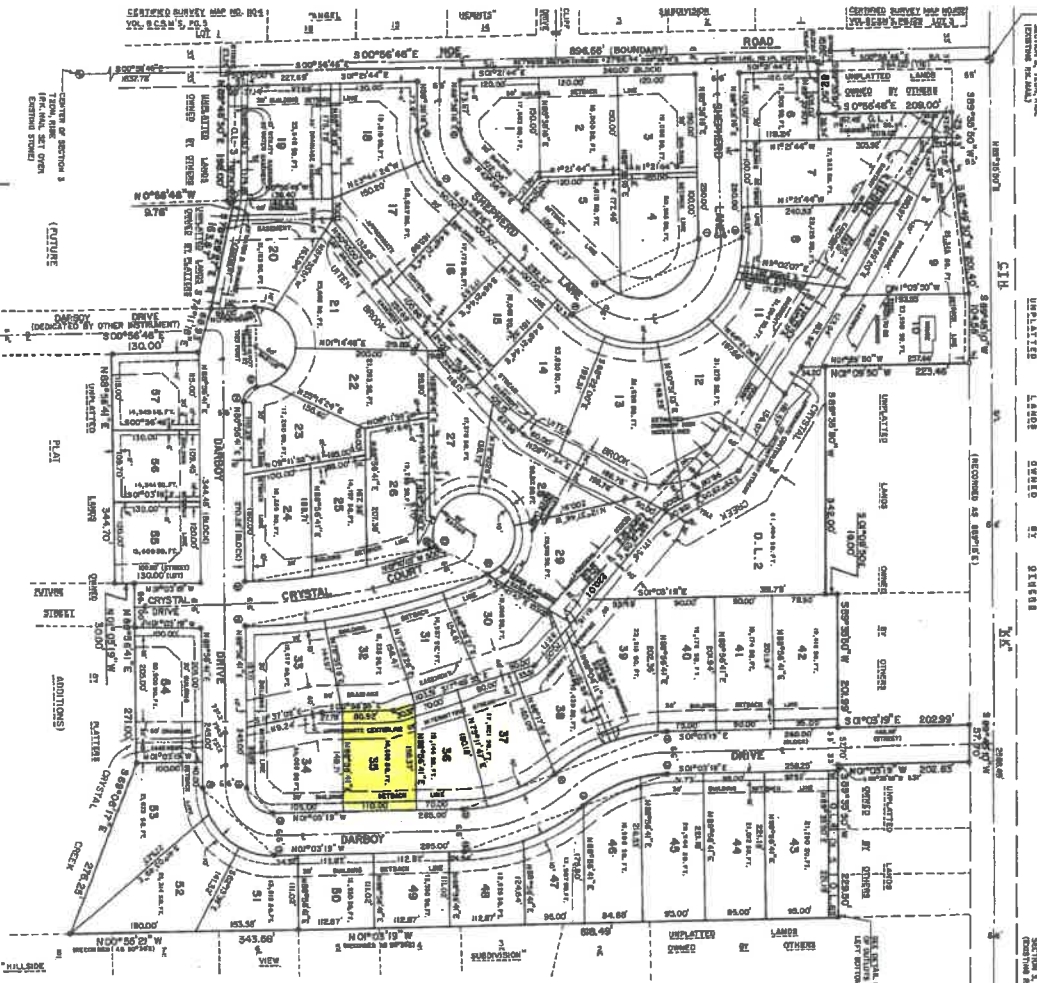

**Permission to Occupy Drainage Easement Agreement**

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This agreement is entered into by and between the Village of Harrison, Calumet & Outagamie Counties, hereinafter referred to as "Village" and Jerome and Sharon Engel, hereinafter referred to as "Owner", owners of property described as Lot 35 of Darbroek Acres, being part of the NW ¼ of the NE ¼ of Sec. 3, T20N, R18E, Village of Harrison, Calumet County, Wisconsin, located at N9641 Darboy Drive.

This agreement authorizes the Owner to place a 8' x 10' Shed, hereinafter referred to as "Improvement", within the recorded drainage easement on their property subject to the following provisions and/or conditions:

1. The Owner agrees that if the Village determines that stormwater runoff is impeded or obstructed at any time because of the Improvement, then the Village may order the Owner to remove such Improvement and return the property grades/elevations to that of the approved grading/drainage plan. If the Owner fails to comply, the Village may cause removal of the Improvement and shall place the cost on the property tax bill as a special assessment.
2. The Owner agrees to remove the Improvement upon reasonable notice from the Village that work needs to be completed within the easement area or that access needs to be obtained through the easement area.
3. In case of emergency, the Village may remove the Improvement without giving notice to the Owner.
4. The Village is not responsible for any damage done during removal.
5. The Village will not replace the Improvement for any reason or reimburse Owner for removal of Improvement.
6. The Owner agrees to maintain the drainage easement, including but not limited to mowing and removal of debris, on both sides of the Improvement.

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**Title:**

Request for Salt Storage

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**Issue:**

Should the village expand its salt storage

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**Background and Additional Information:**

We currently have a 500- ton storage shed that was built in 1996 for a community that had 52 miles of roads. We now have over 100 miles of roads to maintain.

The village is a part of the state's salt bid which means we sign a contract for our salt needs in early April of the previous year. Filling salt orders is a guessing game and depending on the weather you can be in short supply very quickly. We run into this problem often and we'd like to expand our storage.
