## **Background and Additional Information:**

As this is the initial budget meeting I had intended to work through the following outline:

- 1. Basic budgetary introduction: levy limits and mill rates
- 2. Review of what we know is changing for 2022. The following is a list of things that were incorporated into the budget for 2022 so far:
  - a. Changes in Revenue
    - i. Reduced debt payments
    - ii. Levy limit applied to property taxes
    - iii. Reduction in shared revenue
  - b. Changes in Expenditures
    - i. Fire Chief hired full time (net wages, benefits, retirement & FICA)
    - ii. Administrative Assistant hired (wages, benefits, retirement & FICA)
    - iii. Wage increases based on year 1 of Carlson Dettmann study
      - 1. Number not finalized by CD yet
      - 2. Number not approved by Board yet
    - iv. Estimated 5% increase in health/dental/vision benefits
    - v. Estimated 5% increase in property/liability/worker's comp insurance

  - a. Actual increase in health/dental/vision benefits

    - i. Fire Impact Fees
    - ii. Park Impact Fees
    - iii. Police Impact Fees

- iv. Transportation Fees

- e. Water and Sewer Utility budgets
- 5. Review of potential capital projects/purchases for 2022
