Referendums

There are two different types of referendums for this election.

The Village has an "advisory referendum" on its ballot. The purpose of which is to collect the opinions of residents about ATV and UTV use in the urbanized areas of Harrison. The Village Board will take the results into consideration when creating a new ATV/UTV ordinance, but the Board is not bound to follow the majority vote. Type C Notice of Village Referendum

For those in the Appleton and Hilbert school districts, they will also have a "binding referendum" on their ballot. Specifically, they are asking if the school districts can exceed their tax levy limit to pay for a specific project. With a binding referendum, the voters determine the outcome of the project.
